



LAKE MURPHYSBORO

2014 FISHERIES FACT SHEET

LOCATION: This Lake is located within Lake Murphysboro State Park just west of Murphysboro in Jackson County off of State Route 149.

DESCRIPTION: Built in 1950, this 145-acre lake has a shoreline length of 7.5 miles and a maximum depth of 36 feet. Lake Murphysboro has a 10 HP motor limit. Within Lake Murphysboro State Park there are three campgrounds adjacent to the Lake.

STATUS OF THE SPORT FISHERY – The following is a brief summary of the major sport fish species based on annual fish population surveys conducted by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources.

Largemouth Bass – The opportunity to catch bass over 15 inches and weighing 2-3 pounds is excellent in this lake. During the 2013 fall electrofishing survey, largemouth bass were collected at a rate of 118 fish per hour with 15% of the bass measuring 15 inches or better. Eight-percent of the bass collected were over 18 inches in length. Overall the 2013 fall bass survey was one of the better bass surveys on record for this lake. This lake receives more fishing pressure for crappie and bluegill than largemouth bass.

Crappie – Lake Murphysboro has an excellent crappie population consisting of both black and white crappie. Crappie over 2 pounds are caught each year. Of the crappie collected in the 2013 fall electrofishing survey, 39% were over nine-inches in length and 8% were over 10 inches in length.

Bluegill Sunfish – The bluegill population structure can only be described as average. During the 2013 fall electrofishing survey no bluegill over 7 inches were collected.

Redear Sunfish – While the bluegill population can only be described as average, the redear population shows a little more promise with 13% of the redear sunfish collected measuring over 8 inches in length.

Channel Catfish – IDNR stocks 8-10” channel catfish into Lake Murphysboro every year. These annual stockings have produced excellent angling opportunities for 2-5 pound channel catfish.
